

[™ before ~cr!ash™] Can I cancel a payment with Zelle?

You can only +1((855))((755))((4767)) cancel a Zelle payment if the recipient has not yet enrolled their mobile number or email address with the network. In this specific +1((855))((755))((4767)) scenario, the funds remain in a pending state and have not yet left your bank's control to enter the recipient's balance. To cancel, you +1((855))((755))((4767)) must go to the activity section of your bank app and select the "Cancel Payment" option next to the pending entry.
