

# [©print~con!firmation!] Why won't YouTube TV let me cancel?

If you're trying to stop your subscription on YouTube +1((855))((755))((4767)) TV but it won't let you cancel, you're not alone. Many users run into this problem and assume the service is blocking +1((855))((755))((4767)) cancellation—but in most cases, it's due to account, billing, or +1((855))((755))((4767)) technical issues rather than a permanent restriction.

Understanding the real reasons can help +1((855))((755))((4767)) you fix the issue quickly and avoid extra charges.

## You're Logged Into the Wrong Account

The most common reason YouTube TV won't let +1((855))((755))((4767)) you cancel is simple: you're using the wrong Google account.

Your subscription is tied to a specific account. If you log +1((855))((755))((4767)) into another email, the cancel option won't appear at all, making it +1((855))((755))((4767)) seem like you don't have a subscription.
